'15 Funaro, Inzolia, Terre Siciliane, Italy Certified organic. A nearly lost varietal, grown on Sicily's western coast among olive and fruit trees, from a small family producer who makes their own ceramics. Floral, with notes, of olives, salinity, and pear

'16 Bouchie Chatellier, Argile à Silex, Pouilly-Fumé, Loire Valley Exceptional quality in this deliciously fresh Sauvignon Blanc grown in the renowned flinty soil of the region. Grapefruit on the nose is followed by an elegantly dry, round and textured palate

'17 Biohof Pratsch, Grüner Veltliner, Niederösterreich, Austria The most widely planted grape in Austria. Food friendly, slightly herbal, fresh, and spicy with notes of pear, lime, and sweet tart on the palate. Certified Organic 50 (1L) 16 11.5 6

'17 Domaine Guillemard-Clerc, 'Les Parties', Bourgogne Blanc, Burgundy, France Baby Puligny-Montrachet! Hand-harvested and sorted, pressed immediately, then put straight into 20% new Allier French Oak and held for 9 months. Juicy tropical notes combine with white flowers and mineral notes along with green apple, lemon grass, and bright acidity 62 22 16 8.5

'17 Shady Lane Cellars, Pinot Gris, Hennessy Vineyard, Leelanau Peninsula, Michigan Enjoy aromas and flavors of chamomile, pear and green melon. The weight of the mid palate carries hints of almond to a finish of saline minerality 44 16.5 11 6

'17 Hirschbach Piesporter Michelsberg, Reisling Kabinette, Mosel, Germany Sweet and delicious with stone fruit, honeysuckle and delicate floral notes 28 10.5 7 4

'16 Alquimista Cellars, 'Mes Filles' Chardonnay, Russian River Valley, Sonoma, California Barrel-fermented and aged on the lees for 16 months, this amazing single vineyard Chardonnay from acclaimed wine maker Greg Lafollete displays layered aromas of toasted almonds and citrus with rich complexity and bright acidity prolonging on the palate. 75 cases 76

'06 Saint-Chamant, Millseime Brut, Champagne, France Father of Stéphane Coquillet, Christian Coquillet ages this Champagne for 10 years on the lees creating a full bodied, opulent, luxurious wine. Baked apples & pears with Brioche, jasmine & lemon zest. Brilliant and incomparable! 140

NV Nominé-Renard, Brut Nominé, Villevenard, Champagne, France Grower-producer blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Pinot Muenier. Aged 30 months on lees and 6 months after disgorgement. A fresh and elegant Champagne, with lots of minerality and citrus fruits aromas 98

'16 Domaine J. Boulon, Beaujolais Vieilles Vignes, France Very limited production sourced on the border of Morgon. Bright & balanced with fleshy, ripe red cherry, red currant and strawberry fruit 41 15 10.5 6

'15 Pierre le Grand Syrah-Gamay, IGP Collines Rhodaniennes, Rhone, France The vineyard for this cuvee borders on St. Joseph. Very bright and fruity highlighted by cranberry-raspberry, and pepper aromas and flavors 47 16.5 11.5 6.5

'14 Chateau Lestage Cheillon, Medoc, Bordeaux, France From Bordeaux's most famed region: 55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 42% Merlot, 3% Petit Verdot delivering full bodied ripe black-currant and blackberry notes with a dusty finish 54 19.5 14 7.5

'16 Guillaume Gonnet, "Bel Ami", Chateauneuf Du Pape, Rhone, France 50 year old vines from 50% Grenache and 50% Syrah with notes of plum, blackberry, mocha, licorice with rustic earthy notes, and an intense finish 76

'16 Paul Hobbs, Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley, Sonoma County, California Plush, rich, and... pure Russian River Valley. Aromas of dark cherry, tobacco, and cola meet flavors of plum and boysenberry, with notes of truffle and forest floor 92

'13 Tranche, 'Slice of Pape Rouge', Walla Walla, Washington This barrel aged blend of Grenache, Mourvedre, & Syrah has intriguing with compelling aromas and flavors, this is one to spend some time with. 423 cases 75

'16 Turley, Zinfandel, "Old Vines", California With an average age of 80 years old, vines are sourced from Napa, Sonoma, Mendocino, Lodi, Contra Costa, Amador, and Paso Robles. (cherry, plum, smoke, licorice, tobacco) 86

'13 Domaine Lupier, "El Terroir", Navarra, Spain Produced by a husband and wife team saving old vine Granacha vineyards for your pleasure! Dark cherry and leather notes, with nutmeg and cinnamon followed by a dusty rich finish 73

'12 Les Vines de Vienne, 'Sotanium', Vin de Pays de Collines Rhodaniennes, Rhone Valley, France Located a stones throw from Cote Rotie, this is a collaboration between three of France's top winemakers. Brooding & dark with black overripe fruit, pepper and wild game. Seamless. 100% Syrah 105

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
