'11 Patton Valley Vineyards, Estate Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, Oregon
A hidden gem! Produced in small lots and aged on the lees for 11 months. Lush and profound with aromatics of red plum, lavender & a slight smoky note

'11 Tranche, Slice of Pape Rouge, Walla Walla, Washington
This barrel aged blend of Grenache, Mourvedre & Syrah has intriguing with compelling aromas and flavors, this is one to spend some time with. 423 cases produced

'12 Duemani, Cabernet Franc, 'Cifra' IGP Costa Toscana, Tuscany, Italy
Nuanced aromas of bright red stone fruit, wild flowers, sweet herbs and mint. Fermented and aged entirely in cement eggs, this wine is all about the showing off the exceptional fruit in the glass. 125 cases produced

'12 Les Vines de Vienne, 'Sotanium', Vin de Pays de Collines Rhodaniennes, Rhone Valley, France
Located a stones throw from Cote Rotie, this is a collaboration between three of France's top winemakers. Brooding & dark with black overripe fruit, pepper and wild game that blends seamlessly with sage, rosemary and well-integrated tannins. 100% Syrah

'14 Vinas de Aldea, 'Lousas', Ribeira Sacra, Spain
Single vineyard and named for the slate soil this region is known for, this wine is primarily made from Mencia and is a big, powerful wine. Highly complex aromas & flavors of coffee grounds, mocha, leather, clove, cinnamon, baked red fruits and purple flowers are just the tip of the iceberg!
